

## General code of territorial collectivities

### **Article LO 6213-5**

*Created by Law no. 2007-223 of 21 February 2007 - Art. 4 Journal officiel of the French Republic of 22 February 2007*

I.-When the Constitutional Council has determined that a law promulgated after the coming into effect of the aforementioned organic law no. 2007-223 of 21 February 2007 is within the matters falling under the jurisdiction of the overseas territory of Saint-Barthélemy as it applies to Saint-Barthélemy, that law can be amended or repealed by the Territorial Council.

II.-Matters shall be referred to the Constitutional Council by the President of the Territorial Council pursuant to a deliberation of that Assembly, the Prime Minister, the President of the National Assembly or the President of the Senate. The Constitutional Council shall advise the other authorities that have the power to refer matters to it that such a referral, which must be supported by reasons, has occurred; these authorities can submit comments within fifteen days.

The Constitutional Council shall give a ruling within three months.

III.-When they make use of the power given to them by I above, the authorities of the overseas territory must pronounce the express repeal of the statutory provision previously in force and formally enact a new provision.

### **Article LO 6313-5**
